

- The assistant, or bully advocate Assists the bully in bullying, whether by participating in the bullying too, or encouraging the bully by laughing, talking poorly about the target, etc.
- The reinforcer Passively reinforces the bullying by not saying anything at all.
- The non-victim Appears to be bullied, but stands up for the bully anyway, or perhaps doesn't even notice the bullying because it feels normal.
- The mediator Attempts to help the bully and target resolve the "conflict" by going back and forth between the two.
- **The counselor** Serves as an ad-hoc counselor to the target or bully, lending an ear for venting and perhaps offering advice.
- **The defender, or advocate** Attempts to step in during a bullying incident, and may even file a complaint with managers or HR.
